The City Council met on January 28, 2019, in special session.

The clerk stated a quorum was present and the meeting was open for business. Lee Roberts and Captain Entekin were also present.

The invocation was given by Councilman Back.

CANVASSING ELECTION RESULTS

City Clerk Iva Nelson reported on provisional votes to be counted, pursuant to review by the Etowah County Board of Registrars. She proceeded to open the ballots and announce the votes, adding them to the totals recorded on January 22. The following resolution was introduced in writing for consideration:

DECLARING SPECIAL SCHOOL
REFERENDUM ELECTION RESULTS

(Certifying results of special referendum election held on January 22, 2019 - Declaring that majority of votes cast were in favor of an elected school board - Recording 1,245 "yes" votes and 563 "no" votes, including 2 provisional ballots - Determining that special election will be called on a date to be determined, to elect members of the city board of education)

Councilman Williams moved to adopt the resolution as introduced, which motion was seconded by Councilman Cannon and unanimously adopted.

President Toles announced that City Hall will be closed to the public on January 29, if the winter storm affects local travel and the streets are closed.
