- 2. Cynthia Toles received a majority of the votes cast for the office of Council Member for District One and is declared elected to that office for the term beginning on the first Monday in November, 2018.
- 3. Deverick Williams received a majority of the votes cast for the office of Council Member for District Two and is declared elected to that office for the term beginning on the first Monday in November, 2018.
- 4. Thomas Worthy received a majority of the votes cast for the office of Council Member for District Three and is declared elected to that office for the term beginning on the first Monday in November, 2018.

- 5. Kent Back received a majority of the votes cast for the office of Council Member for District Four and is declared elected to that office for the term beginning on the first Monday in November, 2018.
- 6. No candidate received a majority of the votes cast for the office of Council Member for District Five. Jason Wilson and Billy F. Billingsley, Sr. received the most and the second most votes cast for that office. Therefore, a runoff election is hereby ordered to be held on Tuesday, October 9, 2018, pursuant to the requirements of Section 11-46-20 et seq., Ala. Code 1975.
- 7. Johnny Cannon received a majority of the votes cast for the office of Council Member for District Six and is declared elected to that office for the term beginning on the first Monday in November, 2018.
- 8. Ben Reed received a majority of the votes cast for the office of Council Member for District Seven and is declared elected to that office for the term beginning on the first Monday in November, 2018.
