The City Council met on April 2, 2019, in regular session.

The meeting was called to order at 11:00 a.m. by Council President Toles. On roll call by the City Clerk, Iva Nelson, the following council members answered present: Toles, Williams, Worthy, Back, Wilson, Cannon and Reed. The clerk stated a quorum was present and the meeting was open for business. Mayor Guyton, Heath Williamson, Lee Roberts and Chief Jaggars were also present.

The invocation was given by Shane Ellison.

The minutes of the last work session and council meeting held on March 26, 2019, were approved by unanimous vote.

Payment of the HTE System accounts for the week of March 22 -28, 2019 were ratified by unanimous vote.

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PUBLIC HEARINGS

President Toles stated this was the time and place as advertised to conduct the following public hearings:
