Now, Therefore, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GADSDEN, ALABAMA, as follows:

1. No candidate received a majority of the votes cast for the office of Mayor. Craig Ford and Heather Brothers New received the most and the second most votes cast for that office. Therefore, a runoff election is hereby ordered to be held on Tuesday, September 20, 2022, pursuant to the requirements of Section 11-46-20 et seq., Ala. Code 1975.

2. Tonya Lynn Latham received a majority of the votes cast for the office of Council Member for District One and is declared elected to that office for the term beginning on the first Monday in November, 2022.

3. Steve Smith received a majority of the votes cast for the office of Council Member for District Two and is declared elected to that office for the term beginning on the first Monday in November, 2022.

4. No candidate received a majority of the votes cast for the office of Council Member for District Three. Larry J. Avery, Jr. and Denecia Ann Getaw received the most and the second most votes cast for that office. Therefore, a runoff election is hereby ordered to be held on Tuesday, September 20, 2022, pursuant to the requirements of Section 11-46-20 et seq., Ala. Code 1975.

5. No candidate received a majority of the votes cast for the office of Council Member for District Four. Kent Back and Carrie Machen received the most and the second most votes cast for that office. Therefore, a runoff election is hereby ordered to be held on Tuesday, September 20, 2022, pursuant to the requirements of Section 11-46-20 et seq., Ala. Code 1975.

6. No candidate received a majority of the votes cast for the office of Council Member for District Five. Jason Wilson and Billy F. Billingsley, Sr. received the most and the second most votes cast for that office. Therefore, a runoff election is hereby ordered to be held on Tuesday, September 20, 2022, pursuant to the requirements of Section 11-46-20 et seq., Ala. Code 1975.


7. No candidate received a majority of the votes cast for the office of Council Member for District Six. Dixie Minatra and Renay Stokes Reeves received the most and the second most votes cast for that office. Therefore, a runoff election is hereby ordered to be held on Tuesday, September 20, 2022, pursuant to the requirements of Section 11-46-20 et seq., Ala. Code 1975.

8. No candidate received a majority of the votes cast for the office of Council Member for District Seven. Chris Robinson and Ben Reed received the most and the second most votes cast for that office. Therefore, a runoff election is hereby ordered to be held on Tuesday, September 20, 2022, pursuant to the requirements of Section 11-46-20 et seq., Ala. Code 1975.

9. Z. Andre'Huff received a majority of the votes cast for the office of School Board Member for District Three and is declared elected to that office for a four-year term from the certification of the election results.

10. Mark Dayton received a majority of the votes cast for the office of School Board Member for District Five and is declared elected to that office for a four-year term from the certification of the election results.
