Background

The IJP transportation legislation enacted by Congress in 2021 requires that: "An annual listing of projects, including investments in pedestrian walkways and bicycle transportation facilities, for which Federal funds have been obligated in the preceding year shall be published or otherwise made available by the cooperative effort of the State, transit operator, and metropolitan planning organization for public review." 23 CFR 134(j)(7)(8) As required, this report lists all transportation projects authorized or revised to increase obligations of federal transportation funds in the Gadsden Etowah metropolitan region during the MPO program year 2023 (October 1, 2022 to September 30, 2023).

Purpose

The Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) documents the metropolitan region prioritization of limited transportation resources available among various needs of the regions. It is a program and schedule of intended transportation improvements (or continuation of current activities) for the next four (4) years, developed as part of the regional planning process for federal funds received from the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and the Federal Transit Administration (FTA). The GEMPO, in cooperation with ALDOT and designated transit operators and local partners, is responsible for developing the TIP. GEMPO is also responsible for providing citizens, private providers of transportation, and other interested parties with a reasonable opportunity to comment on the proposed program. The TIP must be updated at least once every four (4) years; however, GEMPO conducts full updates on a regular basis and allows for amendments throughout the program year. Once approved and adopted by the GEMPO Policy Committee and ALDOT, the TIP is added to the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) by reference. The TIP contains a priority list of projects to be implemented within each year of the four year program and provides a constrained financial plan that demonstrates that funding to implement projects is reasonably available. The GEMPO Policy Committee adopted the current 2024-2027 TIP on August 31, 2023.

Project Listing

The following table lists projects that had federal funds obligated during FY 2023 (October 1, 2022 — September 30, 2023) and is sorted by project sponsor. The table includes both FHWA funded projects and FTA funded projects, and includes basic data about each project:

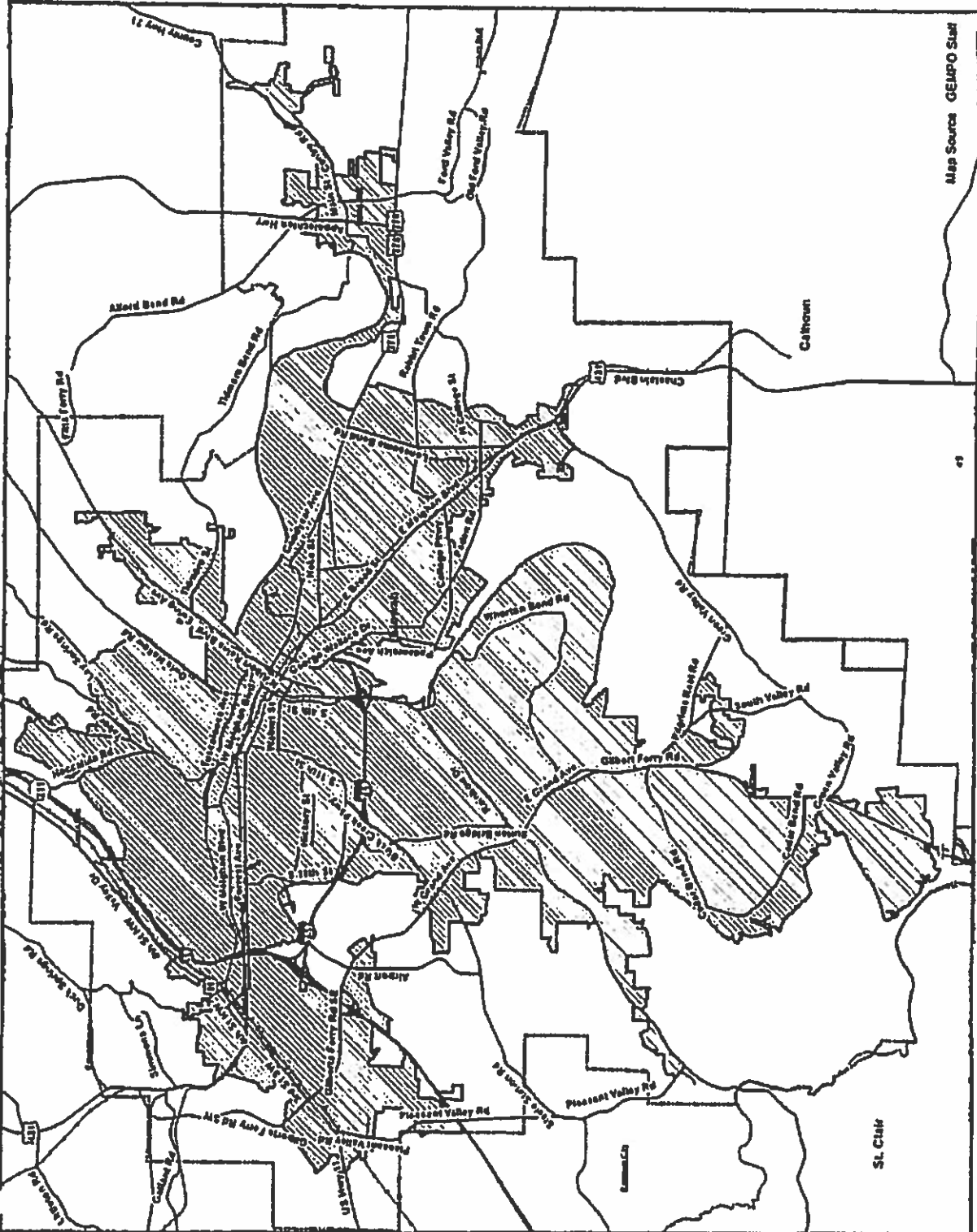
1. **Program:** The Federal Aid program used to fund the project.
2. **Table Number (Table No.):** This is the location of the project based on project type and funding.
3. **Federal Aid Number (FA Nbr):** Number assigned to the project based on the Federal Aid program used to fund the project.
4. **Project Number:** Assigned by the state DOT to identify and track the project. Each phase of the project has its own project number.
5. **Scope:** This describes the phase or type of work to be performed and for which funding was obligated. Only those phases that had funds obligated during the FFY are listed. Below are phases included in the table:
 - a. Preliminary Engineering (PE)
 - b. Right of Way (ROW)
 - c. Utilities (UT)
 - d. Construction (CN)
 - e. For Maintenance (FM)
6. **Length:** The linear distance of the project measured in miles.
7. **Start Date:** Date work is expected to start or did begin.
8. **Type of Work:** Description of improvements or work completed.
9. **% Engineers Estimate:** Project cost estimate.
10. **Federal Obligated:** Amount of federal dollars obligated to the project.
11. **Federal Expenditure:** Amount of federal dollars spent to date on project.
12. **Balance:** Amount of federal dollars remaining in the budget for the project

*Please note that FTA funded projects do not identify individual phases as shown for FHWA funded projects; transit agencies tend to use funds to purchase capital equipment and do not use the funds to build infrastructure projects, as done with the highway programs.
